



# Scottish Spring Middle Distance Bulletin 2 / Final Details



<b>Venue</b>	Bonskeid and Faskally Caravan Park, Pitlochry, PH16 5LD
<b>Date</b>	24 <sup>th</sup> April 2016
<b>Travel information</b>	Leave A9 at B8019 junction just north of Pitlochry. Follow B8019 north for 1.6k to the caravan park on your left
<b>Car parking</b>	£1 per car, please park as directed by parking officials
<b>Toilets</b>	At Faskally Caravan Park only (not at start)
<b>Entry on the day</b>	Blue/green courses - £10, Yellow course - £5. Registration 10:00-12:00
<b>Map</b>	2014 by Stirling Surveys with minor updates. Power lines are removed for clarity. Map is printed on waterproof paper by BML.
<b>Terrain</b>	Mostly very runnable, areas with lower visibility, one steep hill with many crags. Old map <a href="http://www.stag.routegadget.co.uk/rg2/#50">http://www.stag.routegadget.co.uk/rg2/#50</a> . No maps of the area will be available or may be consulted on race day until after the last Elite start.
<b>Start</b>	1.6km taped route to the start, partly along the B8019. Mostly there is a pavement or grass verge, but for a short section competitors must travel along the road. Take great care! U16s should be accompanied to the start by a responsible adult. Signs will be used to warn other road users.
<b>Call up</b>	3 minutes
<b>Warm up area</b>	Available adjacent to the start
<b>Finish</b>	1.4km taped route back to the Caravan Park. Partly on pavement alongside the B8019. Second half is shared with route to start.
<b>Download</b>	All competitors must report to download whether completing the course or not.
<b>Control descriptions</b>	Available loose at the start (printed only on M/W21 maps)
<b>Map change</b>	M/W21, Blue and Green have back-to-back maps
<b>Out of bounds</b>	All fields are out of bounds
<b>Hazards</b>	Livestock, barbed wire fences, crags, fallen trees, river, other users
<b>Timing system</b>	SPORTident
<b>Clothing</b>	Competitors must wear clothing that fully covers their torso and legs
<b>Courses close</b>	14:30
